### **Temporary Renewal of Controlled Dangerous Substances Registrations**

Over the weekend of 12/4/2021, a network security incident occurred involving the Maryland Department of Health's (MDH) information technology systems. As a result, external connections from the MDH network have been blocked, including internet access. OCSA's access to its registrant database has been affected by this and we are unable to verify CDS registration status at this time. MDH's Office of Enterprise Technology is working to assess the situation and we will provide updates accordingly.

Per State Government Article 10-226, if at least 2 calendar weeks before a license expires, the licensee makes sufficient application for renewal of the license, the license does not expire until the unit takes final action on the application. All pending renewal applications that were submitted at least 2 weeks before their expiration date are hereby extended until a final determination on the application has been made by OCSA. Any registrant whose registration is due for renewal should submit their renewal application timely, and their existing registration will similarly be extended until OCSA makes a final determination. When the MDH network resumes normal operations, an email notification will be sent to all registrants and a notice will be posted on our website at <https://health.maryland.gov/OCSA>.

Your temporary registration will be valid until the last day of the month, based on 90 days from the date OCSA received your application.
